5. Short haired watercolour brushes

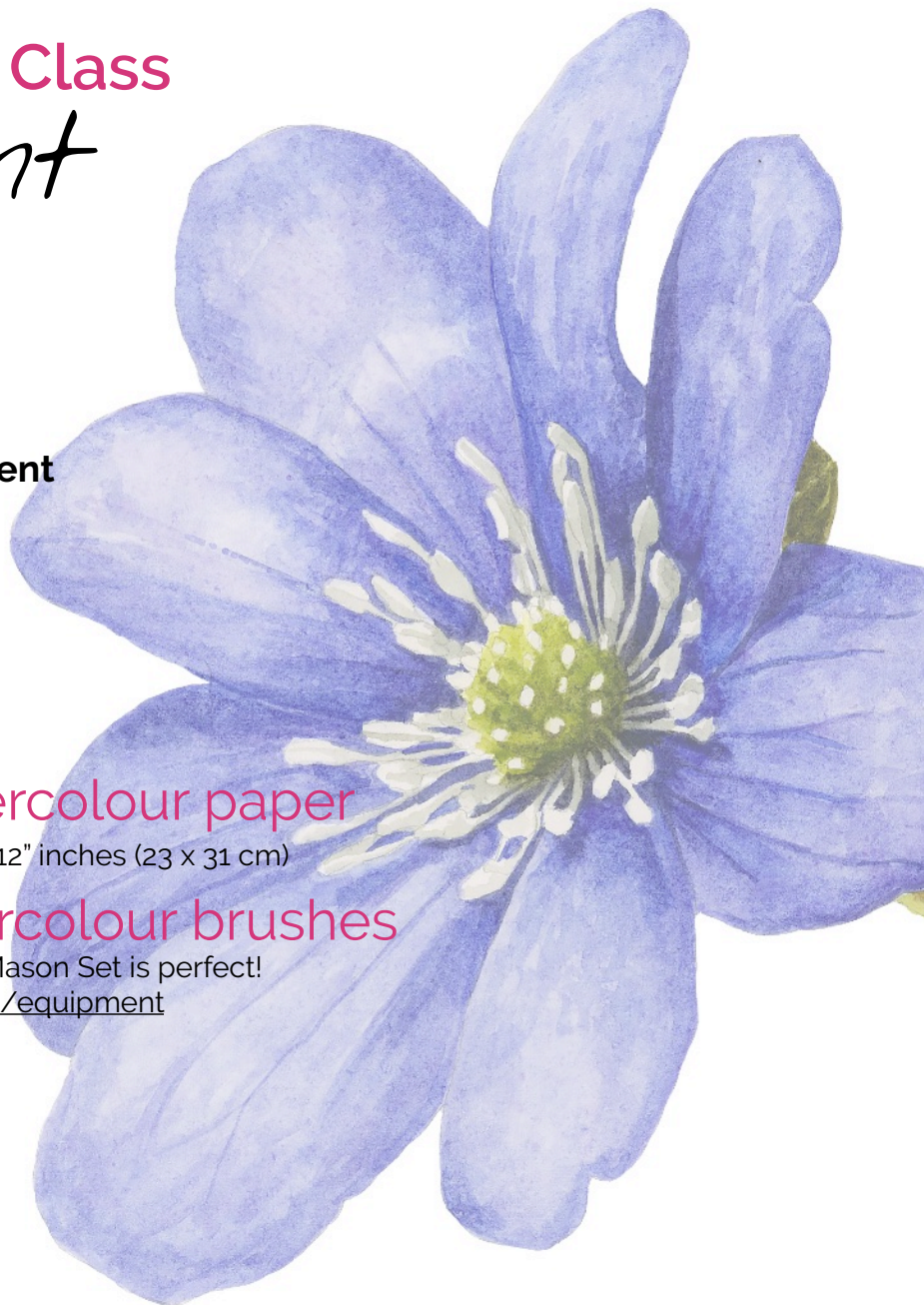

| 1. Burnt Sienna | Quinacridone Burnt Orange | PR101 |
| 2. Cobalt Violet | Cobalt Violet | PV14 |
| 3. Davy's Gray (if you don't have, try a really watery mix of 40% Payne's Gray and 60% Burnt Sienna) | Use a mix of 80% Buff Titanium with 20% Payne's Gray | PG17+PBk6+PBk19+PW5 |
| 4. French Ultramarine | Ultramarine Blue | PB29 |
| 5. Payne's Gray | Payne's Blue Gray (Daniel Smith Payne's Gray is less blue) | PB15+PBk6+PV19 |
| 6. Permanent Sap Green | Hooker's Green (It is more blue than WN perm sap green) | PG36+PY110 |
| 7. Quinacridone Violet (If you don't have: try mixing 70% French Ultramarine with 30% Opera Rose) | Quinacridone Purple | PV55 |
| 8. Winsor Lemon | Lemon Yellow | PY175 |
